FAMILY BIBLE READING PLAN

This is a once a week family worship experience geared toward families with Pre-K and Elementary-aged kids.

We hope this family reading plan helps your family come together to study God's Word. The more you do this, the more it becomes a rhythm in your life and in your kids' lives.

B.R.E.A.D.

The BREAD acronym is a tool designed to help you slow down and prayerfully read the Bible. We will use this to guide us each week.



Be Still

We are going to sit and listen. Find a place where everyone is comfortable and without distractions.



Read

Read the Bible passage or story.



Examine

Use the provided questions to help discuss what you read.



Apply/Activity

Ask, *How does this passage apply to me?* Complete the activity to help reinforce what God is saying through his Word.



Devote to Prayer

Use the prayer prompts to guide you and pray together as a family.

Ask God to help you be a friend that would do anything to share the love of Jesus with others.

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Apply/Activity

Thank God for giving us everything that we have and that we can give freely.

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Apply/Activity

Who can you spend time with that doesn't come to church or know Jesus? Get together with them.

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Devote to Prayer

Ask God to help you share his love to everyone, especially those who don't know him.
